Exhibitor Rule Change Effective 01/01/2010. Chapter 11, Section 1. No dog can enter a licensed or member dog show unless it is either; individually registered with the American Kennel Club, or is individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration. For complete detail, see Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 1. Effective for all events held on and after January 1, 2008 The American Kennel Club will collect a \$3.00 event service fee for the first entry of a dog, and a \$3.00 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). The current 50 cents recording fee will continue to be collected where applicable. The event-giving Club shall be responsible for collecting all the Events Service Fees for the American Kennel Club. The American Kennel Club must receive all fees within seven (7) days of the close of the event, along with all other required event results.

ACKNOWLEDGMENTS: Entries will be acknowledged after the entries have closed. Entry acknowledgment and judging program to be sent to the address on entry. Should an exhibitor NOT receive the entry acknowledgment within a reasonable time, please notify the Show Secretary at the address provided. PSSSS will not accept any entry that includes or specifies any conditions. Telephone, telegraph, fax, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will get returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and or Show Secretary assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the dog owner or agent who entered a dog in a class that the dog is not eligible to compete in. **THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE COMPLETENESS OF ANY ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH THE ENTRANT.** PSSSS will not refund any Entry fees if a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it was entered incorrectly. **There is no refund of the entry fee for bitches in season, except for bitches enter in Junior Showmanship, Obedience, or Rally.** There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES OR, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management, if it is impossible to hold the show.

No dogs will be allowed in the show area except those entered. The judging will start promptly. Dogs may arrive anytime before their time of judging and may leave immediately afterward unless required for further judging. Exhibitors are responsible for having their dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class.

FOR LOSS AND OR DAMAGES: The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors. The Show Committee and Event Secretary will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the case of any injury or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this event. The responsibility and welfare of an exhibitor's child are assumed to be the exhibitor's responsibility. All exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show.

The Club has the right to substitute a prize for equal or more value. Trophies must be claimed on the day of the show. No prizes will be mailed or otherwise distributed.

SWEEPSTAKES CASH PRIZES are awarded to the handler showing the dog while in the ring. Prize Money Claims for the prize money must be made while in the ring and before the breed judging is over. The Show Secretary and The Club disclaim any liability for cash prize after the Breed judging is over.

All PERSONS ATTENDING THIS DOG SHOW waive any claim for damages against THE CLUB, its members, or agents in the event that a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

THE CLUB, ITS SHOW SECRETARIES, THEIR AGENTS, EMPLOYEES, ETC, WILL USE DUE CARE AND DILIGENCE FOR THE WELFARE OF DOGS AND EXHIBITORS BUT WILL ASSUME NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY LOSS, DAMAGE, OR INJURY SUSTAINED BY EXHIBITORS, HANDLERS, OR TO ANY OF THEIR DOGS OR PROPERTY PARTICIPATING IN THESE SHOWS, AND FURTHER ASSUMES NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR INJURY TO CHILDREN AT THESE SHOWS.

ANY EXHIBITORS OR PERSON they employ found to be littering or failing to clean up after their dogs will be brought before the Event Committee.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS: THE CLUB DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS AS SET FORTH ON THE OFFICIAL AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB ENTRY FORM FOR THIS EVENT.

ENGLISH SETTER ASSOCIATION OF AMERICA **Sanctioned Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy)** **ENGLISH SETTER NATIONAL ONLY** **Judge: Eugene Blake**

This is an abbreviated version of the AKC Regulations (regarding the 4-6 Month Puppy competition.) Please refer to the regulation for a full description of this class. One combined class will be offered for dogs that are four months and under six months as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*. There will be a selection of Best of Breed Puppy.

Dogs must be four months of age and under six months. Dogs are required to be vaccinated in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized. AKC Rules in Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in Rules applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise. AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows. Exhibitors should plan on opening the mouth of their puppy for the judges. Classes will not be divided by sex in this competition. Breed standard disqualifications such as color, height, weight or dentition shall not be a point of consideration in the judging process for this 4-6 month Puppy Special Attraction event.

Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler.

Best of Breed Competition : The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed/Variety Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed/Variety Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

Award of Merit for Superior Quality: (ESAA) At the discretion of the judge, up to five awards of Merit from dogs/bitches in Best of Breed may be awarded.

Best Bred-By-Exhibitor and BBE Eligibility - All dogs entered in the Bred-By Class must be individually registered with AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. Family members must be both a breeder and owner of record to exhibit in the class. Any entry in the Bred-By- Exhibitor classes that is awarded Best of Breed or Best of Winners would automatically be Best Bred-By-Exhibitor. Only the dog or bitch not defeated in Bred-By-Exhibitor are eligible for the Best Bred-By -Exhibitor competition.

Best Puppy - Any entry in the puppy classes that is awarded Best of Breed or Best of Winners would automatically be Best Puppy. Only dogs not defeated in a puppy class are eligible for Best Puppy Competition. Best Bred By Puppy will be able to compete for both Best Puppy and Best Bred By Exhibitor.

Best in Veteran Class. - Any entry in the Veteran class that is awarded Best of Breed would automatically be Best in Veteran Class. Only dogs not defeated in Veteran class are eligible for Best In Veteran Competition.

HEALTH CLINIC

The 2025 Health Clinic will be on Tuesday, September 23, 2025, from 8:00am-2:00pm at the host hotel. As in the past ESAA will be contributing funds towards screening to keep costs low for members. This year we will be offering AKC/DNA screening, and AKC Reunite ISO microchips. We will also offer Thyroid Panels submitted to Michigan State University, OFA, CHIC, and DNA Repository. Appointments and payment must be made in advance of the clinic.

AKC/DNA screening is a simple non-invasive procedure to determine parentage and genetic identity of the dog. You will need to fill out paperwork first, so please arrive 15 minutes before appointment. Upon completion, the owner will receive an AKC letter of DNA analysis containing the sample dog's registration information, DNA profile number and dog's genotype. The cost to members will be \$25 per dog.

AKC Reunite ISO microchips will also be available at the Health Clinic. The ISO microchip is internationally recognized as a form of permanent identification. Purchase of the AKC Reunite ISO chip includes lifetime registration into the AKC Reunite database and an identifying collar tag. Any changes such as address or contact information can be updated at any time at no charge. The procedure produces little if any discomfort and the microchip can be placed on puppies older than 8 weeks. The cost to members will be \$15 per dog.

Thyroid panels will be sent to Michigan State University for processing and interpretation. Guidelines for testing are as follows:

- No bitches "in season" will be screened.

- Stop supplements for 1 week prior to the clinic.

- Dogs must not be on Thyroid supplement (e.g., Thyrozine, Thyroxine or Soloxine).

- If supplements are included in diet, and contain Kelp, discontinue prior to testing. Kelp can alter test results.

- Have dates available of last vaccinations, both Rabies and Distemper/Parvo.

- Dogs should be fasted prior to blood draw.

- Dogs MUST be 1 year or older to be screened.

Cost to members will be \$45/dog.

OFA, CHIC, and DNA Repository collections will be sent to OFA. This collection provides a free source of DNA for future health research. The cost to Members is \$10.00 per dog.

If you have not received an email confirming your appointment and registration at least a week before the clinic, please contact Paula Spiering.

REGISTRATION CLOSES: Same as show entries . – Additions after the close of registration is on a space available basis and clinic time will not be extended. **PLEASE PLAN TO ARRIVE 10 MINUTES BEFORE YOUR APPOINTMENT**
